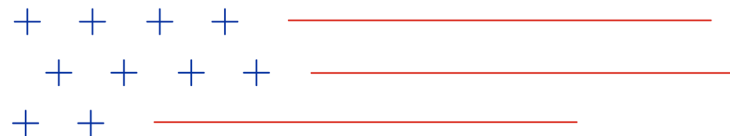


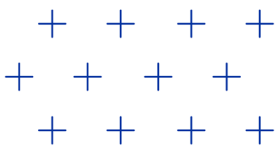

7 weeks | Full-Time, Mon-Fri

Partner: Fayetteville Technical Community College (FTCC)

Funding: WIOA workforce grant (if residing in NC), GI Bill (2 months), unit-specific training funds if available, and/or out of pocket. Very limited scholarships are available on a case-by-case basis.

Total Cost: \$2,507

Housing: Barracks available for all active duty, including part-time Reserve & National Guard

6 weeks | Full-Time, Mon-Fri

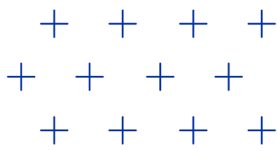

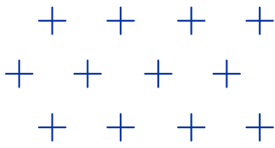
Course Enrollment



- Enrollment Requirement
 - FAA 8610-2 required prior to the start of class
 - 30 months of practical aircraft maintenance experience or 18 months of either Airframe or Powerplant experience
- Who can attend the course?
 - Active Duty (not transitioning)
 - Active Duty (transitioning)
 - Reserve/National Guard
 - Veterans
 - Military Spouses
- What are the options for time off work to attend the course?
 - Options depend on an individual's active duty status, time until date of separation, or if already separated
 - Heroes MAKE America is an approved DoD SkillBridge and Army Career Skills Program (CSP)
 - Options: PTDY, SkillBridge or CSP Packet, personal or transition leave, or other direct approvals from a supervisor



Course Structure



Week 1

- **Orientation** (mandatory)
- **Career Readiness Instruction***
- **Local Manufacturing Tours***
- **Independent Study**

** Career readiness & manufacturing tours are mandatory for transitioning service members and highly encouraged for all other students to attend. These courses include (but not limited to) resume writing, interview preparation, and connection to our HMA Placement Manager.*

Weeks 2+

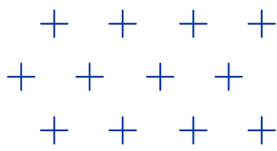
- **Classroom Lecture:**
Preparation for 3 written tests
- **Written Test Completion:**
General, Airframe & Powerplant
- **Hands-on Training:** In lab practice for Oral & Practical (O&P) exams

Post Course

- **Individual O&P exams**
- O&Ps are dependent on DME and student availability
- Service members still active duty must coordinate with their leadership to approve time off to take O&Ps
- O&Ps typically take 1-2 full days to complete



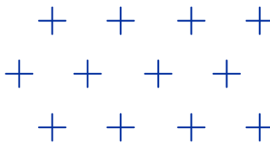
Included in Cost of Course



- **Study Materials**
 - Dauntless Prep Software
 - FAA e-manuals
 - Fort Bragg also provides hard copy supplemental textbooks & manuals
- **Written Test Costs (\$175/each x 3 tests – G,A,P)**
 - Fort Stewart & Fort Bragg students test in-house with education partner
 - 1st attempt included, all retests are taken at the cost to the student
 - McConnell AFB students test on installation (1st attempt and retakes are free)
- **O&P Exams (Typically \$1500 total | \$500/each O&P x 3 sections – G,A,P)**
 - Each school coordinates with local DMEs to schedule individual O&Ps
 - If a student resides outside the training area, the student must either stay local after the course to test, or they must locate and facilitate with a DME in their home area. The school will do their best to coordinate the scheduling process but cannot guarantee due to individual DMEs having their own test scheduling & payment requirements.
 - 1st attempt included for all sites, all retests are taken at the cost to the student. Cost may vary based on location.
- **Technology**
 - Personal laptops are required for the McConnell AFB and Fort Stewart locations
 - School loaner laptops are provided at Fort Bragg for the duration of the course

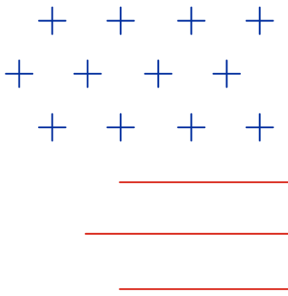
